The Executive Committee met on Wednesday evening, May 13, 2017. Here is a report of their meeting.

- Officers for 2017 were elected. They are:

- The Treasurer reported that we now have 129 members, up from 98 in 2016, including 19 new rental owner members recruited by our recent letter to rental property owners. She also reported a current balance of \$1,032.44.
- SHNA made a donation of \$50 each to Sunset Hill Elementary and West Middle School for their Community Mercantile Education and Outreach Programs, \$25 to help pay for food for the Murrow Ct. block party, and \$50 to the Sunset Hill Library in memory of Hazel Stellmacher, a long-time SH resident who died tragically in a house fire last month.
- The EC authorized Matthew Paul to purchase a domain name for a SHNA website and begin work on a prototype. We hope to have the SHNA website up and running with the next three months. Thanks Matthew!
- The EC authorized Gary Webber to send an email to SHNA members asking for volunteers to serve as a Safe Routes to Schools Champion for one of the two schools in our neighborhood. You will be receiving that email soon.
- Thanks again to all of you who came to our annual meeting at Sunset Hill Elementary! It was well-attended and productive. Unfortunately, many of you had difficulty hearing the speakers. We will try to find a better venue for next year's meeting with less background noise.
